The Institut Supérieur des Langues Vivantes-français offers courses of level beginner, intermediary and advanced to students. On the first day, a level test is organised to evaluate students' skills (in French) and put them in a suitable group.

Every student receives a frequency certificate at the end of the training course.

An assessment test (50 €) can be organised on request (need of ECTS, marks in the country of origin, etc.).

Goals of the training:

The intensive French course aims to:

- Develop student's speaking and writing skills depending on their level;
- Develop academic skills in French (reports, summaries, written works, etc.);
- Improve students' knowledge about the Wallonia-Brussels community with the optional module "Culture";
- Improve speaking skills for communication with the optional module "Conversation";
- Improve students' speaking skills (pronunciation, grammar, listening comprehension, etc.) with the optional module "Laboratory";
- Promote cultural exchange and cross-cultural dimension between students from all over the world taking part in the courses;
- Introduce the Wallonia-Brussels Federation's heritage with the cultural activities organized in the afternoons.

Schedule:

60 hours of courses:

- 45h hours of speaking and written language,
- 15h hours dedicated to an optional module (laboratory, Belgian French speaking culture, conversation).

Courses take place every morning from 9:00am to 1:30pm.

Cultural activities are organised in the afternoons with an additional cost (cost of the activity and the supervision).

Methodology:

These courses are given by graduated teachers / Master in romance philology and specialised in teaching French as a foreign language (FLE). They give priority to communicative and interactive methods (role-playings, global simulations, conversations in small groups...) and use audio-visual and computer media.

Special feature of the training:

These French courses allow students to improve significantly their knowledge of the language and also to compare their culture by learning to live and work together.
